

Do I have to be 21?

Yes. Due to Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) regulations, all guests must be over the age of 21. IDs will be checked at the entrance.

I love the wines! Can I buy a bottle at the event to take home?

YES! New Alabama laws allow us to fulfill wine orders on premise at such tasting events. We can also take orders and you can pick up your order the next week at Church Street Wine Shoppe.

Can I bring my baby?

No. Although adorable, due to Alcoholic Beverage Control regulations, all guests must be over the age of 21.

Can I bring my dog?

No. Although also adorable, due to both city and event health code regulations, dogs are not allowed in the Downtown City Park. This applies to other pets as well, including but not limited to cats, parrots, rabbits, etc. Licensed service animals are welcome.

Can I bring a chair?

No chairs but blankets are welcome near the band and picnic area of the Park.

Can I buy tickets day-of?

Tickets may be purchased day of pending availability, but at an additional \$10 per ticket price (example – General Admission 5 - 9 p.m. would be \$60 at the door.

My plans changed, can I get a refund?

No, all tickets are non-refundable. No exceptions. However, they are transferable to another guest, but only for the current festival year.

Can I bring my own food?

No outside food, beverages or ice chests, please. We will have local food trucks on site with wine inspired menu items and water will be available at the Fred Bread and Dayspring Dairy tent located by the stage.

Will there be food?

Yes, there will be food available for purchase from a selection of Food Trucks. There will be complimentary bread and cheese tent as well. However, we always encourage taking time to enjoy a hearty dinner with the food trucks!

Do I have to pay for anything once I enter the event?

Not if you don't want to. We will have a variety food trucks with fantastic offerings available for purchase, as well as Wine Festival t-shirts and other fun merch.

Are there souvenirs for purchase?

Yes. We will have a selection of Wine Festival t-shirts and wine lanyards to make your tasting experience hands free and more enjoyable!

Is smoking allowed?

Smoking is prohibited near any of the tasting tents, there will be a designated area at the festival.

Is handicapped parking available?

Yes. Handicapped parking is available in the parking garage on Church Street.

Where can I stay?

We have a variety of accommodations available ranging from [Embassy Suites](#) to [Springhill Suites](#) both located downtown.

What should I wear?

The Wine Festival will be held outside in the Downtown City Park, so we suggest checking the projected [weather report](#) and dress accordingly.
